To hear the word of God and share in the Lord's supper:
There is time in my life to come to worship
For the well-being of my soul and the well-being of the congregation, I am willing to make it a priority to worship God with the congregation regularly.
God is at work in Holy Communion to strengthen my trust in God's goodness and my ability to allow that goodness of God to be evidenced in my life all week.
God's desire to love me is at the heart of a relationship. I will claim time and ways that are meaningful for me to be with God in listening and talking with God, in silence with God, and in reading/learning more about Jesus are what it means to live as a follower/disciple of Jesus every day.

To proclaim the good news of God in Christ through word and deed:
In my speaking, I will give God credit when credit is due to God.
God has given me the ability to listen and others seek me out as a listener.
I will recognize the opportunities God has given me to act in caring ways when they arise.
God has given me the ability to pray for others, and I pray for others.
No matter where I am, if asked about Jesus, I'd be willing to have conversation.
Any place I am is a place where others can see the love of Jesus in my actions.
To serve all people, following the example of Jesus:
When I become aware of a true need someone has, I am willing to do my part in assisting.
There are times when my heart is moved to act in extraordinary ways to care for others.
My daily work contributes to the web of life and provides me with income to support my life.
My understanding about people and their ways needs to grow as I listen to their stories.
God's will for my life is written into my very abilities, interests, energy and creativity so that I can care for others in all that I do.
Daily work, play and rest provide the opportunities for living with care for others as well as myself.
People are always looking for people to do things. I recognize that my time and energy are limited and that at times the Holy Spirit will lead me to say "no" to invitations and opportunities so that I have time for rest and renewal – maybe even going out to the mountain to pray, as Jesus did!
To strive for justice and peace in all the earth:
God has entrusted the earth to me as my home, as well as the home of the 8.2 billion other people living on earth. I seek to have my personal choices contribute to the wellness and promotion, and not the destruction, of the health of the earth.
Advertising messages promote personal comfort and desires. Following Jesus means that advertising messages will often numb me to the concerns of others in order to get what I want. I will pray for wisdom to recognize this effect and a heart that has the courage to limit my wants more to my needs so that I am freer to share with others of my time, money and energy.
Daily news brings the world into my home. I can "pray the news" seeking to care about others and hear where God may call me to action on behalf others.
God created a great diversity in humankind. Our communities include only a large portion of that diversity. Seeking out relationships with people different from oneself breaks down the "me/us –them" categories and contributes to building peace. I'm open to getting to know people different from me.
Wealth is a tremendous responsibility and easily lures one into self-centered living. I pray that God will lead me in stewarding well the resources of money, land and belongings that are in my control.
Jesus is always going ahead of us into the challenging and hard places of life. I will seek to grow in trust that I might be willing to follow Jesus beyond my personal comfort level into new ways of caring about and for others.
